

# Resilient SRQ Voluntary Buyout Program

## Scoring Criteria

### Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet all of the minimum eligibility criteria listed below to be considered for CDBG-DR funding.

1. Proposed project benefits low to moderate income (LMI) persons or urgent need in accordance with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) National Objectives.
2. The proposed project must be an eligible activity. Eligible activities include:
  - Acquisition following Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (URA);
  - Demolition of structures associated with acquisition;
  - Relocation assistance with buyout or acquisition (following URA)
3. The home must have been owner-occupied at the time of Hurricane Ian.
4. The home must have served as the primary residence by the homeowner.
5. The project must have a direct or indirect tieback to Hurricane Ian.
6. The property must be in a designated disaster area (Myakkahatchee Creek and Hidden River) or be a repetitive loss property.
7. Property must be maintained in perpetuity for a use that is compatible with open space, recreational, floodplain, and wetlands management practices, or other disaster-risk reduction practices in compliance with HUD requirements.

Project Impact	Project demonstrates the pre-storm value of the home, ensuring that the requested amount is proportionate. The project includes factors like contiguous properties, which help strengthen the overall impact and resilience of the community. <b>0 - 25 points</b>	0-25
Maintenance Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant has not described steps to maintain the project in perpetuity - <b>0 points OR</b></li> <li>• Applicant has described steps to maintain the project in perpetuity – <b>25 points</b></li> </ul>	0 or 25
